1. They can be 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional pieces.
2. 3-D projects must fit on top of a (6ft ? or 8ft? X 30in) table taking up no more than 1/3 (30”x30”) of the table top.
3. Projects must be created by a student. Adult instruction is understood and acceptable.
4. Art “kits” are not permitted.
